The importance in coming together as a body of Christ

• **Mat 26:27** Then he took a cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, **all of you**. 28 This is **my blood of the covenant**, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins. 29 I tell you, I will not drink from this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom."

The importance of participation

• **1Co 10:15** I speak to sensible people; judge for yourselves what I say. **16** Is not **the cup of thanksgiving for which we give thanks a participation in the blood of Christ? And is not the bread that we break a participation in the body of Christ?** **17** Because there is one loaf, we, who are many, **are one body**, for we all share the one loaf. **18** Consider the people of Israel: **Do not those who eat the sacrifices participate in the altar?**

The reason it is dangerous not to participate

Heb 10:19 Therefore, brothers and sisters, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place **by the blood of Jesus**, 20 by a new and living way opened for us through the curtain, **that is, his body**, 21 and since we have a great priest over the house of God, 22 **let us draw near to God** with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water.....

23 Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. 24 **And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, 25 not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another-- and all the more as you see the Day approaching.** 26 If we **deliberately keep on sinning after we have received the knowledge of the truth, no sacrifice for sins is left,** 27 but only a fearful expectation of judgment and of raging fire that will consume the enemies of God. 28 Anyone who rejected the law of Moses died without mercy on the testimony of two or three witnesses. 29 How much more severely do you think someone deserves to be punished who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, **who has treated as an unholy thing the blood of the covenant that sanctified them, and who has insulted the Spirit of grace?** 30 For we know him who said, "It is mine to avenge; I will repay," and again, "The Lord will judge his people." 31 It is a dreadful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.
