













Average Annual Snowfall in the Northeast & Midwest

NWS Gaylord Forecast Area










Acts 21: The Separation of Jerusalem
The separation of Jerusalem was a significant event in the early church's history. It occurred in the year 36 AD, when the Jerusalem church was divided into two groups: the Hellenists and the Hebrews. The Hellenists were those who had been converted to Christianity by Paul and other missionaries, and they spoke Greek.
